## OBJECT OF ROTARY

The general objectives of Rotary clubs in every country are the same - the development of fellowship and understanding among business and professional leaders in the community, the promotion of community-betterment endeavors and of high standards in business and professional practices, and the advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace.

The object or Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and to encourage and foster:

FIRST: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service.

SECOND: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying by each Rotarian of his occupation as an opportunity to serve society.

THIRD: The application of the ideal of service by every Rotarian to his personal, business and community life.

FOURTH: The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional men and women, united in the ideal of service.

## ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Missing four (4) consecutive meetings may result in loss of membership.
- 2. A member failing to attend sixty (60) per cent of the meetings in either half of a Rotary year may forfeit membership. (This is a minimum of fifteen (15) meetings each half year.
- 3. If, for business or health reasons, a member cannot attend the regular meeting of the Rotary Club of Bartlesville, he can make up at any other Rotary Club in the world. This should be done within two weeks, on either side of the regular meeting date.
- 4. Leave of absences may be requested.

## FEES AND DUES

The admission fee shall be \$45.00 to be paid on admission to membership.

The annual membership dues shall be \$260.00, payable either quarterly(\$65), annually(\$260) or semi-annually(\$130) at the option of each member, with the understanding that a portion of each semi-annual payment be applied to each member's subscription to The Rotarian magazine.

Included in the \$260.00 annual membership dues is a project assessment of \$80.00 for the purpose of financing Rotary projects. The project assessment is a tax-deductible contribution.
